The objective of this assignment is to support DRIVE to define homogenous Unit Areas of Insurance (UAIs) and support the design of a drought index insurance product that fits with the agro-ecological, seasonal and livelihood needs of the pastoral households in Ethiopia, Kenya, and Somalia. The Consultant will undertake all the specific tasks detailed in the Terms of Reference. The consultant service is expected to be conducted and reports delivered within 5-months from commencement.

Zep-Re (PTA Reinsurance Company) now invites eligible consulting firms to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.).

The short-listing criteria are as follows:

1. Core business of the firm and at least 3 years in UAI delineation for Insurance purposes.
2. Experience in conducting similar assignments, at least 3 years in Product Design Preparation and customization, Unit Areas of Insurance (UAI) determination, and Scenario analysis. The Consultant shall provide the name and contact address of the Client (office and e-mail address and telephone number), date(s) of execution, name (s) of lead and associate firms, contract amount, and financing sources.
3. Experience of relevant services in an environment similar to that of Somalia, Kenya or Ethiopia; and
4. The technical and managerial organization of the firm. (Provide only the structure of the organization). Do not provide CVs of staff). Key experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage.
